Rental outlets that have deployed the mobile solution have experienced reductions in the average number of days rental equipment is held in inventory between rentals: from an average of 7 days to less than 2 days. Customer close rates are dramatically improved at the point of interaction and inventory turns on the back-end are increased through real-time mobile access to customer and inventory data.

"We looked at adding a mobile extension to the application so that our customers could do real-time tracking of their business anytime, anywhere. We quickly encountered very complex technical issues that were beyond the scope of our expertise," said Ray Bonestroo, president of Genisys.
